We are excited to partner again with your school and to be the sanctioning body for your indoor tournament. With that being said, we just want to make sure every player participating in your event has a valid player card on-site and that it has been verified at tournament check in and before each match by the ref. With this not being a TSSAA event and TUSC being the liable group we just want to make sure we are by the book.

We request that this info is sent to all teams that have registered and posted on your website.

Due to TN State Soccer Association requirements for events sanctioned through member clubs and potential liability issues, TUSC is required to verify that every player who is participating in a TUSC sanctioned event has a player card and medical release form to be checked at tournament registration. This will be the responsibility of the on-site tournament director during that tournament and then the responsibility of the TUSC registrar for follow up processing at the completion of tournament registration.

In the event that a player does not have a player card they may purchase a temporary TN State Soccer Association player card for \$15 on site that can be used throughout the indoor season. This player will be given a "tournament card" to be used for check in before each game and at following TUSC sanctioned tournaments. We will provide a form for the parent to fill out with required info. This info and money will be given to the TUSC registrar for official registration with the TSSA.

If a player is a student at the host school a card is still required from either the club that player is a member of or by purchasing a TN State Soccer Association temporary card on site. This will mostly apply to high school aged players. If they are a TUSC player they will need to simply get their player card from their TUSC team manager. If they are a HSC or other rec player they will just need to provide documentation showing their current and active status of registration with that organization.

If a player is a member of another TN youth club they will have to provide the player card from that organization or purchase a TN State Soccer Association temporary card on site.

Every TUSC player must provide their TUSC player card to participate regardless of where they go to school or what school is hosting the event. TUSC players can not dual roster by purchasing a TN State Soccer Association temporary card through TUSC on site.

Refs are to check player cards before every game. The refs are responsible for the players who are participating in each match. Please ensure that each player on the court has been approved.
